

Reunion Concert *1968~2008*

Three members of the Boise High School Class of 1968 will present a concert at St. Michael's Cathedral on Sunday, August 10, 2008, at 4:00 PM.

John Cochrane, Dr. Christopher Lindbloom, and Sir Frank Reid Smith will present music for violin, voice, and piano. The three worked together as students at Boise High School and have pursued their musical careers in separate venues during the last forty years.

After five years of study in New England, John Cochrane returned to Boise and currently teaches public school music programs. He has been a member of the Boise Philharmonic as violinist and violist since 1966.

Christopher Lindbloom is a First Vice President - Financial Consultant with RBC Wealth Management in Richmond, Virginia. He is an active singer who performs vocal music across the country, including nineteen years at the Corona del Mar Baroque Music Festival in California.

A church mission served in Finland led to a successful career in diplomacy for Sir Frank Reid Smith, who was knighted by the government of Finland in 2001. Mr. Smith makes his home in Phoenix, Arizona, and performs as a pianist in the United States, Europe, and Africa. He currently serves as the Consul of Mauritius in Arizona.
